STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council's reasons for proposing the following orders are to help facilitate the passage of vehicular traffic.

This is in line with the Council's commitment to reducing emissions and encouraging the take-up of electric vehicles in the city, the Council has committed to providing electric vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure to meet the needs of EV drivers.

The Council intends to install new Rapid chargepoints and, in order to ensure charging spaces are available for EV drivers and not blocked by other vehicles, the Council intends to make these mandatory EV charging bays.
